REFERENCES IN THE TEXT

- References of up to three authors: separate by an 'en-dash': (Sparks – Talcot 1970) × for more than three authors: (Carandini *et al.* 2002)
- Compound surnames: (Mfeaaskant-Kleibrink 1992)
- Edited works: (Torelli ed. 2000; Augusta-Boularot – Lafon eds. 2004)
- In case no author/editor name is available, use an abbreviation of the title or the venue: (*Formazione* 1988; Bologna 1988)
- Arrange multiple citations in chronological order of their issue, from the oldest one to the newest one, separating them by a semi-colon: (Boardman 1989; Cook 1995)
- References to Greek or Cyrillic works within the body of the article should be transcribed to Latin: (Katz – Struzheckiy 1975)

BIBLIOGRAPHY

- All references should be listed in *alphabetical order* (arranged chronologically from the oldest one to the newest one) at the end of the paper headed '**Bibliography**' (no colon, bold)
- Ancient sources should be listed first followed by a space and the secondary literature
- Several works by a single author issued in a single year (Bouzek 2011a; Bouzek 2011b; Bouzek 2011c) are to be arranged in alphabetical order of the first letter of their title

ABBREVIATIONS

You may cite the titles of periodicals, corpora (CVA, CIL etc.) and encyclopaedias (e.g. "RE") in their abbreviated form, in the case that you provide your paper with a list of the used abbreviations. For abbreviations please follow the system used by the Archaeological Institute of America¹ or by the DAI².

ANCIENT SOURCES

REFERENCES WITHIN THE TEXT

- Name of the author reduced to an understandable and unambiguous extent + (if necessary) *abbreviation of the work cited*: e.g. Livy; Caesar *BG*; Dionysios Hal.
Caesar, *BG* I, 5.4 = first book, fifth chapter, paragraph four
Caesar, *BG* I, 5.2-4 = first book, fifth chapter, paragraphs two to four
Caesar, *BG* VII, 55.4,6 = seventh book, chapter fifty-five, paragraphs four and six

LIST OF SOURCES

- Includes all the used ancient sources, i.e. both translations and editions of the original text.
- Use Name of author + abbreviation of the work used in the text + '=' followed by complete name of the author ':' name of the work in *italics*, edition + number of volume, editor/s or translator/s, place and year of issue.
- If you are referring to your own translation, specify if you are translating from the Latin/Greek original or from its translation into modern language.

Translation:

- Caesar, *BG* = Gaius Iulius Caesar: *The Gallic War*. Transl. H.J. Edwards. Caesar I. Loeb Classical Library 72. Cambridge Mass. 1917.

Edition:

- Plinius, *NH* = C. Plinius Secundus: *Naturalis Historia*. Bibliotheca Teubneriana. Editor: Karl Mayhoff. Volume I (book I.-VI.), Leipzig 1906.

Online sources:

If the online source refers to the original edition and keeps its structure,³ the online source might be referred to as a book. If it is not so, use the following structure:

- Arrianos, *Ann.* = Arrian, *Anabasis*. English translation E.J. Chinnock, 1893, [online]
